I DON'T KNOW WHAT TO SAY OTHER THAN OUR PRODUCERS ARE ON THEIR KNEES AND MARKETERS NEED GREATER ACCESS TO PENETRATE HIGH VALUE MARKETS TO SUSTAIN HIGH VALUE HORTICULTURE. BASED IN MILDURA OUR BUSINESS IS AT THE COAL FACE OF THE EXPORT PROBLEM AND THE PRODUCER PROBLEM WHICH THREATEN THE FABRIC OF OUR COMMUNITIES.
