IPCC aims to provide the world with a clear scientific view on the current state of knowledge in climate change. Working Group III is concerned with reducing greenhouse gas emissions. The Head of Operations will have overall responsibility for the operational, administrative and financial aspects of the TSU.

The post holder would be educated to degree level or equivalent in a relevant subject. A management, finance or HR qualification or equivalent would be desirable. You must have substantial experience of managing budgets and of producing and interpreting financial reports as well as experience of managing staff.

You must have strong, interpersonal and influencing skills with staff at all levels as well as excellent organisational skills and excellent verbal, written communication and presentation skills. Proven ability to identify, propose, plan and implement services and processes are essential. You must also have the ability to work under pressure whilst managing conflicting deadlines, and working flexibly in a rapidly changing environment. The post-holder will be required to travel overseas, for periods of up to 7-10 days as a member of the TSU team.

This is a fixed term position until 31 March 2020, in the first instance with a possibility of extension subject to funding.
