Art on the Manukau

Old Mangere Bridge, Friday 28 – Sunday 30 November 2014

Other Waters is a two-pronged art programme that takes the Manukau—Auckland's southern harbour—as its inspiration and its subject. The main part of the programme is **a weekend-long, community-focused outdoor art event, on 28 - 30 November 2014, centred on the Old Mangere Bridge** (accessible via Onehunga Harbour Road at the north end, and from Coronation road, Mangere Bridge at the south end).



The participating artists and curators wish to draw public attention to the Manukau Harbour and its foreshore, an area sometimes overlooked in favour of Auckland's more developed northern coastlines. The featured artworks speak to immediate local issues, as well as to the more general fact that New Zealand is an island nation surrounded on all sides by vast bodies of water which have to be crossed in order to get here (as indeed they were crossed by the earliest Pacific navigators).

At the outdoor event on the weekend of 28-30 November, there will be live dance performances on Old Mangere Bridge, video projections on the Holcim cement silos, a dawn hiko from Mangere Maunga, a performance by children from Onehunga Primary School paying tribute to the waka rescue of the wreck of the Orpheus, planting activities, and much more. These have been devised by a number of the participating artists and performers, including many who live around the Onehunga area or elsewhere on the Manukau. A caravan kindly provided by Te Tuhi will be stationed on Coronation Road at the southern end of Old Mangere Bridge, to provide information about the event.

Accompanying this is an exhibition proudly hosted by Te Tuhi which runs from 15 November 2014 to 15 February 2015. **All are invited!**
