CalSWEC Scholarships

Title IV-E MSW Program

Two years of financial support for public child welfare careers. \$18,500 per student per year. Available at most MSW graduate schools.

Title IV-E BSW Program

One year of support for full-time students in public child welfare. \$15,000 for the final year of study. Part-time students limited to current employees of a county or the state Department of Social Services. Program available at select schools.

Mental Health Stipend

Provides a training stipend of \$18,500 per year for second year graduate level social work students selected into the Mental Health Stipend Program (MHSP).
