The primacy of racialization principle illuminates how research criminalizes black males across all ages.

The social construct principle provides researchers a lens to consider how criminalizing black males poses a risk and limits healthy identity formations.

The race consciousness and interdisciplinary self critique principles requires better understanding of how biases, discrimination, and abuses of power lead to justifiable homicides.

Death by legal intervention is defined as the killing of a person by a law enforcement officer or other peace officer with specific legal authority to use deadly force acting in the line of duty.
