## The Peltier Extradition: False Affidavits

To extradite Leonard Peltier from Canada, the U.S. Attorney and Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) created false affidavits of Myrtle Poor Bear, which they had coerced this frightened woman to sign, and which they knew to be false. Today, the government concedes that, in fact, Myrtle Poor Bear did not know Peltier and that she wasn't present at the time of the shooting on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation, 26 June 1975.

- I am an American Indian born February 20, 1952, and reside at Allen South Daketa, one of the United States of America.
- 2. I first met Leonard Feitier in Bismarck, North Dakota, during 1971. Duving March, 1975, I again met Leonard Feltier at St. Francis, South Dakota, United States of America. During April, 1975, I went to North Dakota to see him as a girl friend of his. About the last week of May during 1972 I and Launard Feltier went to the Jumping Bell Hall near Oglah, South Dakota, United States of America. There were several hotses and about four or five tents. When Leonard Politer arrived, he gave orders on what was to be done. I was his girl friend at this time. About a week after me arrived, about the second work of June. 1975, Leonard Peltier and asserted others began planning how to kill either Bureau of Indian Affairs Icpartment, United States Government police or Federal Bureau of Lavesligation, United States Government, agents who night come into the area. Leonard Peltier was mostly in charge of the planning. All persons involved in the planning had special assignments. There was also a detailed escape route planned over the hills mear the Jumping Bull Hall area. I was present during this planning. Leonard Feltier always had a rife and usually had a pistel near him. The pistol was usually under a can seat. Myrtic Foor Sear, being first duly sworn, deposes and states:

- I am an American Indian born February 20, 1352, and reside at Allen, South Dakota, one of the United States of America.
- 2. I first met Leonard Peltier in Bismarck, North Baketa. during 1971. During Kareb, 1975, I again met Leonard Peltier at St. Francis, Scuth Dakota, United States of America. During April, 1975, I want to North Dakota to see him as a girl friund of his. About the last week of May during 1975 I and Leonard Peltier went to the Jumping Bull Hall near Oglela, South Dakota, United States of America. There were several houses and about four or five tents. When Leonard Politer arrived, he gave orders on what was to be done. I was his girl friend at this time. About a week after we arrived, about the second week of June, 1975, Leonard Peltier and several others began planning how to bill either Bureau of Indian Affairs planning how to kill either Bureau of Indian Affaira Department, United States Government points or Federal Bureau of Investigation, United States Government, agents who might some into the area.   Dog's Paradise on the Rosebud Indian Esservation, South
  Dakota, United States of America. We talked about the killing of the two Federal Bureau of Investigation agents near Juneping Bull Hall. Leonard said it makes him sick when he thinks about it. He said that one of the agents surrendered, but he kept shooting. He said it was like a mevic he was watching but it was real, he was acting right meyer he was waterang out a mind and just started shooting. It is said he shot them and just kept pulling the trigger and coulds't stop.

Affidavit 1–February 19, 1976 (above left): Here, Special Agents David Price and William Wood have Myrtle Poor Bear recount how it was she who overheard the planning of the Northwest AIM group to lure Special Agents Coler and Williams to their deaths in an ambush. Note that there is no claim Poor Bear witnessed the shoot-out, but that she heard Leonard Peltier order the agents killed beforehand, and that he later "confessed to her."

Affidavit 2–February 23, 1976 (above right): With this affidavit, Price and Wood have Poor Bear present herself as being Peltier's "girl friend," and as overhearing planning for an ambush. However, with this affidavit, Poor Bear is now presented as having witnessed Peltier killing the agents. Details on an escape route apparently were designed to explain away the Bureau's embarrassing inability to apprehend suspects at the scene of the shoot-out. Also note how the method of killing corresponds to the FBI's contrived "execution" scenario.

## Milderit

Myrtle Poor Rear, being first duly swom, deposes and states:

- That I am the Myrtle Poor Bear, of Allen, South Dakota, United States of America, who was the deponent in an affidavit awarn the 23rd day of February, 1976. This affidavit is sworn by me to give further information.
- 2. Attached herete and marked Exhitit "A" to this, my Afidavit, is a photograph marked February 12, 1976, and I testify and depose that the person shown on the said photograph is a person known to me as Leonard Peitier and is the person I spoke of it my deposition of February 22, 1976, and the person referred to herein as Leonard Peltier.
- 2. I recall the events of June 26, 1975, which occurred at the area of Jumping Bull Hall near Ogials on the Pine Rudge Indian Reservation in the State of South Dakots, United States of America.
- 4. Sometime during the early part of that day, at approximately 12:00 Koon, Lecuard Peltier came into the residures of Harry Jumping Bull which is located in the area of Jumping Bull Hall and said, "They're coming." I understood this to mean that police or agents of the Foderal Bureau of Investigation were in the immediate area. A short time later, I saw a car which I recognized to be a government can near Harry Jumping Bull's house. I went down to the creek bottom a couple of hundred yards from the house. I heard shooting I left the creek bottom area and walked approximately 50 yards to where I saw two mars, both of which I recognized to be government cars, because of the large radio antenness mounted on the rear of these cars and I had previously seen many cars of a similar type driven by government agents in the same area. When I got to the car, Lamard Peltier was faining a fine I nearly after the as a special agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. This mea was tall with dark heir. This man threw a handgun to the side and said something to the effect that he was surrendering. Leonard Peltier was pointing a rifle in the direction of this man. The man was holding his arm as if he was wounded and was leaning against the car previously mentioned. There was another man who I believed to be a special agent of the Federal Bureau of Investigation lying face down on the ground and there was blood underneath him. I started to leave and was grabbed by the hair by another person and could not

get away. I turned again and saw Leonard Peltier shoot the man who was standing against the car. I heard a shot come from the rific that Leonard Peltier was holding and I saw that rife jump up still in his hands. I saw that man's body jump into the air and fall to the ground. The man fell face down on the ground. This happened in an instant. I freed myself from the person that was holding my and ran up to Leonard Peltier just as he was airling his rific at the man who had just fallen to the ground. I pounded Leonard Peltier on the back. He yelled something at me which I cannot recall. I turned, ran and left the area. As I was running away, I heard several more shots from the ween from which I had just fied.

Note also the absence of any alleged confession on the part of Leonard Peltier.

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
