

## Employment and Volunteer Opportunities at the Earth First! Journal

The *Earth First! Journal* Collective welcomes people from all over to come and work as "short-term" members of the collective. This adds to the diversity of voices and energy in "the *Journal*"—as we refer to the publication within the EF! movement and *EF*! *J* office.

The *Journal* Collective is currently producing a bound magazine, released 3-4 times a year. We also maintain two websites, including a daily newswire and produces a newsletter on the cross-quarter calendar of the printed magazine. Due to these changes in our production schedule and increased media projects, we can't guarantee that a new issue of the *Journal* will be produced in-full during your time on the collective. However, you will definitely be able to be a part of the production no matter when you arrive.

Short-termers need to be physically in Lake Worth, FL for a minimum of two months and work a minimum of 20 hours a week in order to receive a \$200/month stipend. If you are more interested in having a looser schedule or working from afar, still fill out this application and let us know what kind of work (either paid or volunteer) you are interested in committing to.

During your time in Lake Worth, the *Journal* collective members will help provide a room for you to stay in while you're working on the publication and *Journal* projects. Housing opportunities vary throughout the year: some involve work trade, sometimes they are free and other times rent is involved. Please let us know what your housing preferences are so we can try our best to accommodate you. Short-termers are invited to build a bike at the local community bike shop, Outspokin, if a spare is not available.

We are always looking for long-term members for all of our collective projects from business management, editorial work and the Earth First! Speakers Bureau. After at least one short-term period, new collective members can become specialized and decentralized from the Lake Worth *Journal* office.
