

PISA PRODUCTS LICENCE

This licence is granted by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) in accordance with the goals of the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) to allow free access to trustworthy information and data on the knowledge and skills of students worldwide and the performance of their education systems.
