Orb Community Arts is a unique creative and educational space right in the heart of Knaresborough and easily accessible from Harrogate, York and Leeds. With up to date Music and IT facilities, an Art Space, an Eco Garden and an outgoing team of teachers, staff and volunteers, Orb is here to help people develop invaluable life skills, grow in confidence, gain experience, and think positively about their future.

What do we do?

Orb delivers a wide range of activities and courses, designed to equip clients with the relevant skills and knowledge to give them the edge in a range of creative fields. Specialising in Music Production and Technology, Performance, Composition & Songwriting, DJing and Instrumental lessons, we also provide learning in Film & Video Production & Editing, Digital Photography, Blogging, Web Design, Basic IT Skills, Art and beyond.

In the community

We don't just offer these creative and learning opportunities though. Orb also regularly provides **Sound, Lighting, Recording & Event Support** to a wide range of schools, charities and community groups and believes strongly in playing its part in the life of the local area. Our inclusive and dynamic **Volunteering Programme** also ensures that both our service users and members of the wider community can participate in delivering our services, learn new skills, gain experience and help contribute to a stronger, more dynamic and inclusive community.

What courses do we do?

Orb prides itself on its flexibility. We try and offer our Service Users a course that reflects their individual interests and goals, in a way and at a time that suits them. Teaching can be group based but is often one-to-one and every effort is made to accommodate service users own particular learning styles. We also encourage people to get involved in mentoring & volunteering opportunities and put their new skills to use getting some real, practical experience. Who do we support?

Orb aims to support those most at risk from exclusion from mainstream support and provision. This includes people who are:

- Experiencing Mental III-Health
- Learning Disabled
- On the Autism Spectrum
- Have Low or Outdated Skills (including the elderly and digitally excluded)
- Homeless
- Recovering from Substance Misuse
- Unemployed
- Carers

We accept funded referrals from a range of partners and are keen to develop relationships with new ones. Current referrers include:


Self-referrals can sometimes also be accepted if accompanied by evidence of economic inactivity and benefit entitlement and we have access to funding to support this. This is not always possible but we encourage people to check with us on a regular basis.

How Much Does It Cost?

Our regular provision to referred service users is based on half day or full day sessions. These include guided learning hours and supported access to the facilities. We can often offer free access to some services and facilities though availability and eligibility can vary. Contact us for current opportunities.

Community Events



Working with such clients as the **Frazer Theatre** in Knaresborough, **The Lions & Rotary** Clubs, and a wide variety of local schools, churches and charities, Orb aims to actively benefit the community. We want to make the place we live more vibrant and creative whilst offering our service users and volunteers the opportunity to get real life work experience and play a valued role in the local area.

Where are we and how do I get there?

Orb is based in the centre of Knaresborough in North Yorkshire. There are over 6 buses an hour to Harrogate and rail connections to Harrogate, Leeds and York. Both the bus and rail stations are only a 5 minute walk away. We have limited parking in front of the building but you will need to ask for a private pass upon arrival.

Our premises are situated alongside Knaresborough Bowling Club at the end of the alleyway by Tesco on Knaresborough High St. There is alternative vehicular access via Park Crest. We are in the old garage with the black doors. Look out for the Orb logo!
