Set to open autumn 2016, Dubai Opera will offer the ultimate flexibility of a proscenium arch theatre, an acoustic concert hall and a 2,000m2 flat floor event space. The configuration will allow for approximately 2,000 seats for a concert and up to 1,000 for a gala dinner.
