

THE KILLING SEASON UNCUT

by Sarah Ferguson with Patricia Drum

Based on the acclaimed ABC documentary series

Australians came to the ABC documentary series *The Killing Season* in droves, their fascination with the brutal Rudd–Gillard struggle as enduring as the saga itself. This is the book that goes behind the scenes of the series, candidly revealing the untold stories of the interviews and the uncut comments of the key players. For the first time a more complete version of the truth is revealed.

Kevin Rudd and Julia Gillard dominate the drama as they strain to claim the narrative of Labor's years in power. Rudd gives his painful account of the period and recalls in vivid detail the events of losing the prime ministership. Gillard is frank and unsparing of her colleagues.

More than a hundred people were interviewed for *The Killing Season*— ministers, backbenchers, staffers, party officials, pollsters and public servants—recording their graphic accounts of the public and private events that made the Rudd and Gillard governments and then brought them undone. It is a damning portrait of a party at war with itself—of the personal rivalries and bitter defeats that have come to define the Rudd–Gillard era.

It is also a remarkable insight into the work of Sarah Ferguson, one of Australia's top journalists.
