Items are scored as follows: Not me at all =1; A little me =2; Me = 3; Very much me=4

So for this example Bring people together =3, Help others in person=3, Spend my leisure time with other people=3. Total for the three People items =9. Using the score chart, an item total for 9 in the People dimension is a People score of -0.9529. (which is quite low)

For Physical, there are four items: Construct things, camp, Run, and Play sports. In this sample that comes to 4+4+2+4=14. Using the score chart, an item total of 14 in the Physical dimension is a Physical score of 1.29326. (which is quite high). Similarly for Idea and Object.

Zero is the average. 1.0 means one standard deviation above the average, which is quite high. -1.0 is one standard deviation below average, which is quite low. Of course, if someone skips a question, you cannot construct a score for that dimension.

When you have a group of at least 30 people, you can take the average of all their scores. Differences of 0.3 or greater are reported as meaningful.
