Large-Scale Donation Proposal Outline

This outline is intended to provide a recommended framework from which to develop a large-scale donation proposal for consideration under the CBP Donations Acceptance Program (DAP). The CBP DAP defines large-scale proposals as those where the estimated upfront costs are expected to exceed \$3 million, and generally speaking, are of moderate to significant size, scope and complexity.
