- **No. 10 TU men's lacrosse beats Denver in NCAA first round:** Facing long odds after winning a preliminary round game against Hobart on last week, the Towson University men's lacrosse team answered the call on Sunday, knocking off second-seeded Denver, the defending national champion, 10-9, at Peter Barton Lacrosse Stadium.

Current Campus Construction Underway:

- West Village Phase 3 & 4: The building will be located west of Towson Run apartments and Douglass House. Combined, they will contain 325,000 gross square feet of space, including a mix of two- and four-bedroom apartments with single-occupancy bedrooms and shared bathrooms, kitchen and living space. Construction is scheduled for **completion in summer 2016**.
- Burdick Hall Expansion: This project will nearly double the size of Burdick Hall with a 94,000 square foot addition which will include two multi-purpose athletic courts, an indoor running track, a mind and body studio for yoga and Pilates classes, a dedicated cycling studio and a combat studio. An accompanying 8,000 square foot renovation will update existing offices and the mezzanine level of the existing fitness center. Construction will elevate the grounds on the south side of Burdick, completing the pedestrian walkway that extends from the West Village to York Road. **Estimated completion in fall 2017**.
