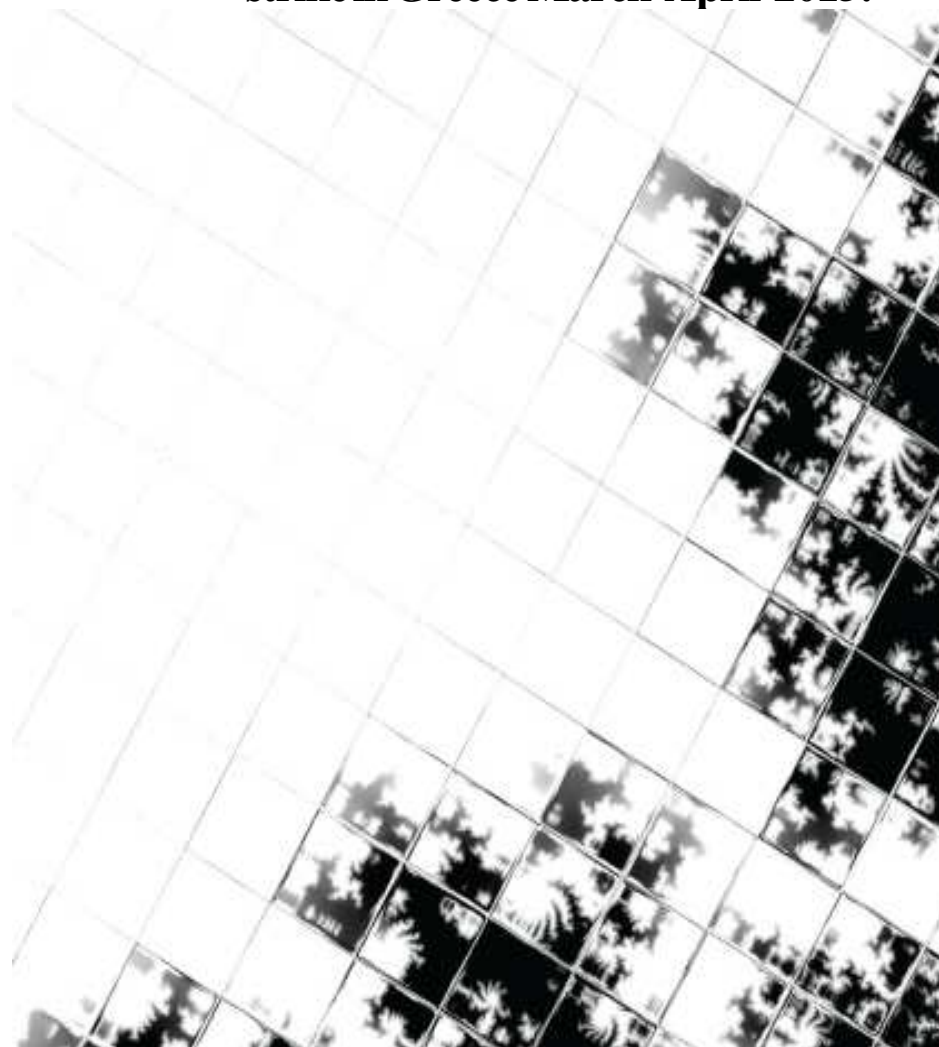

Prison Society

We all live in a prison society, the separation between the prisoners in any prison and the rest of us is a purely technical one. We can see this if we look at how the world map is divided on a large scale, then reach the core of how societies are structured in ways that exist in microcosm inside prisons, both materially and in terms of relationships.

The law, which only exists by consensus, has become interiorised as a measure of 'right' and 'wrong', where to kill one person is 'murder' and punishable by law, whereas killing thousands en masse on orders of the State and capital in wars or through starvation is legal, therefore 'normal'. Taking something to eat from the shelves of the supermarket is stealing, robbing the lives of those who produced the goods thousands of miles away is perfectly legal. Inside as outside there are those with consciousness of the world we are living in and fight it, those who don't want to know or submit without any perspective.

There is no difference, and so we stand together, each individual that is consciously fighting for their dignity against the common enemy in all its forms. We are in solidarity with the prisoners in struggle, seeing them as part of the same society that we all want to destroy and not as something separate.

Solidarity

Solidarity with prisoners should not be seen as humanistic and compassionate. It can't be a reserve for a necrotic movement with so many fronts in the struggle, to act or react against like a duty. Our solidarity needs a goal, and that is to destroy the foundations of

this society that builds prisons. It must be a dynamic, critical and practical expression. Our struggle is constant and total and will not end until we dance upon the wreckage of the existent, and part of this fight should be and is our solidarity with the prisoners.

Anarchists never place themselves as political prisoners but as prisoners of the social-class war. All are prisoners of the State and capital; for our comrades, they can be said to be imprisoned anarchists. Their struggle for freedom and the destruction of the existent continues behind the bars in multiform ways, with all the complexities of living in a hermetically closed microcosm of society outside.

Inside like outside, external control and surveillance has moved forward with totalitarian democracy to the point that they want us all to actively participate in our own exploitation, our own imprisonment. They will give us the key to lock ourselves in the cell so long as we accept collaboration through given identities and roles. Anyone who doesn't play the game is suspect and dangerous, and all prisons have isolation wings for the uncontrollables.

About the Category C prisons in preparation

Conditions are no different inside the Greek prisons to those in the Asian, American and all the others. People locked up in small cells, humiliated every day by the screws, unable to make their own decisions. Currently the greatest number of prisoners in Greece are immigrants and the economically excluded, as well as drug users and all those whom the State designates as marginal. And then there is a significant number of anarchists, social fighters and outlaws. For anarchists, there is no such thing as a division such as 'criminal' and 'political' prisoners.

In the past many struggles have been carried out inside the Greek prisons for conditions etc. In March 2014 a new struggle began against the law for the new high security prisons. The State wants to build prisons and wings with a new level of separation among prisoners. In the first level, that they call type A wings, there will be all the people arrested for economic crimes or non payment of fines etc.; the second level will be the type B wing which keeps a huge number of prisoners like the prisoners we have now. But the new level will be a type C wing for those who have been accused under the antiterrorist law, those accused of being in criminal organisations and those who have taken part in struggles inside the prisons. In type C wings the prisoners won't get days of leave, they will be locked up in a cell 23 hours per day, their relatives won't be allowed visit them frequently, and there will be censorship of mail. The minimum time served inside these prisons will be ten years and every moment of them will be monitored by CCTV cameras.

The cells will have no contact with any natural light or air. Security will be undertaken by heavily armed special police forces who will use their guns at will. Finally, anyone who gives information about other prisoners concerning their participation in armed struggle groups will be set free. With this law we see clearly the State's project to eliminate anyone who, having chosen to undertaken by heavily armed special police forces who will use their guns at will. This is the true face of democracy, in a frenzy to punish its enemies at a time when life is

Thousands of anarchists in Greece have inspired and ignited passions of comrades everywhere. The Greek State wants to punish and exterminate them. Announcement of DAK (Network of Combative Prisoners) ending the hunger strike - 18/4/15

Announcement of DAK (Network of Combative Prisoners) ending the hunger strike. After 48 days of struggle we are ending the hunger strike we carried out together with other political prisoners, against the legal manifestation of the anti-revolutionary and wider social strategy of the State expressed through special legislations of exclusion.

After yesterday's completion of the procedure in parliament, an important part of the demands placed by the Network of Combative Prisoners, were in part won.

Specifically:

- The legal framework that defines the operation of C'type prisons.
- The abolishment of the burdensome provision for acts carried out with covered faces (hoodie law), the minimum limit of sentencing for demonstrations and robberies was decreased from 10 to 5 years (leaving the frame of evaluating the conditions under which the act was carried out, up to the judge).

We share the life-giving flames of satisfaction with all those who felt this battle as a common cause.

P.S. I In the future we will make a thorough statement concerning the matters this struggle opened. About its limits and the different outcomes it could have, given the new political and movement rhythms which itself highlighted and with which it proceeded. Because only through honest review and critical dialogue can we secure even more victorious struggles.

P.S.2 The day the legislation was voted into parliament, the "leftist" government clearly showed the real face of authority. The morning evacuation of the occupied Rectorate in Athens and the arrest of comrades who were inside is the living proof that authority will

and make the matter of political prisoners a social matter. In this way it acquires social and popular foundations and acceptance.

In my opinion this hunger strike carried out by political prisoners surpasses even the demand frame it itself puts.

This hunger strike ought to be a militant mobilization that will rally the political prisoners, the solidarians, the anarchist anti-authoritarian movement against the nature of the regime we are living under, against capitalism itself which created the crisis we are experiencing and its results, against the memorandums and the rescuing programs, against the State that defends the interests of supranational capital that fortifies itself with anti-terrorist laws and C' type prisons, because it fears the revolution. Against all governments, and today's SYRIZA government which seeks to politically disarm us and assimilate us.

Because this government also serves the lenders, it signed the extension of the existing memorandum, it will sign a new memorandum in the summer and because they also fear the revolution. I believe this hunger strike is a great opportunity for the anarchist anti-authoritarian movement, with coordination and a spirit of unity, to open up to society and intervene by connecting solidarity to political prisoners with the revolution. In this way the hunger strike and the struggle of those in solidarity will be a good political legacy for the future.

Hunger strikes in Greek prisons

6/3/2015 - A brief chronicle of the past few days

While the Greek society is watching the post-election fables of the SYRIZA-ANEL coalition government in an almost dormant state, incarcerated anarchists and combative prisoners in the galleys of democracy have once again decided to clash with Power and its laws, using hunger strike and abstention from prison food as weapons of their struggle.

On February 27, 2015, Giorgos Sofianidis, a social prisoner in the E1 wing of Domokos maximum security prison, begins a hunger strike demanding to be transferred back to Koridallos prison, where he was held until New Year's Eve, so that he can continue his studies at the Technological Education Institute of Piraeus and the Institute of Professional Training of Koridallos prison. At the same time, along with his fellow inmates, he claims the definite abolition of type C prison.

On the same day, all other prisoners in the E1 special wing of Domokos – anarchists Nikos Maziotis, Kostas Gournas, Yannis Naxakis, communist Dimitris Koufontinas, and social prisoners Alexandros Meletis, Konstantinos Meletis, Vasilis Varelas, Mohamed Said Elchibah, Alexandros Makadasidis – declare prison food abstention, stating they will continue their mobilisations. Besides, in early February, a joint protest was carried out by inmates in Domokos prison in response to yet another death of a prisoner because of medical negligence.

On March 2, prisoners that share a common political context of demands launch a hunger strike, mostly aiming at abolishing the 2001 and 2004 antiterrorism laws, articles 187 and 187A of the penal code, the 'hoodie law', the legal framework for type C prisons, the prosecutorial provision of forcible taking of DNA samples, and demanding that the convicted 17N member Savvas Xiros be released from prison on health grounds. Those who announce their

participation in the collective mobilisation are Kostas Gournas and Dimitris Koufontinas with a joint statement, Nikos Maziotis (type C prison of Domokos), and five comrades from the Network of Imprisoned Fighters (DAK); namely, Antonis Stamboulos (Larissa prison), Tasos Theofilou (Domokos prison), Fivos Harisis, Argyris Ntalios and Giorgos Karagiannidis (Koridallos prison). The rest of the participants in the Network of Imprisoned Fighters will join the hunger strike later on. On March 2, Mohamed-Said Elchibah also initiates hunger strike in the type C prison of Domokos. A day later, two women incarcerated in the female section of Neapoli women's prison in Lasithi, Crete, declare their abstention from prison food in solidarity with political prisoners on hunger strike.

Meanwhile, since February 28, police have arrested several people in relation to the case of the Conspiracy of Cells of Fire attempted escape from Koridallos prison: Christos Rodopoulos, anarchist fugitive Angeliki Spyropoulou, Athena Tsakalou (mother of the Tsakalos brothers) and a friend of hers, a friend of the brother of Giorgos Polidoros, as well as the wife of Gerasimos Tsakalos. Therefore, on March 2, CCF imprisoned members Olga Ekonomidou, Michalis Nikolopoulos, Giorgos Nikolopoulos, Haris Hadjimihelakis, Gerasimos Tsakalos, Christos Tsakalos, Giorgos Polidoros, Panagiotis Argirou, Damiano Bolano and Theofilos Mavropoulos announce a hunger strike until death or until their family members and the friends of their relatives are immediately released. Angeliki Spyropoulou, from the holding cells at police headquarters, also goes on hunger strike with the same demand. On March 4, anarchist Panos Michalakoglou, held in pretrial detention in the prison of Nigrita in Serres, initiates abstention from prison food in solidarity with CCF hunger strikers. Both friends of relatives of CCF members are released, however the bastards Nikopoulos and Asprogerakas, special appellate judges in charge of the investigation, order that the mother and the wife of Gerasimos Tsakalos be remanded to prison. Additionally, two more arrestees are sent to pretrial detention; namely, hunger striker Angeliki Spyropoulou (Koridallos prison) and Christos Rodopoulos (Domokos prison). Furthermore, on March 6, Christos Polidoros (brother of CCF member Giorgos) is also arrested and currently held by the antiterrorist unit.

In these conditions where the regime in Greece continues to be unstable, where it has lost social consensus because of the crisis, the memorandums and rescuing programs that have brought mass starvation, poverty, misery, thousands of deaths-murders from suicides and illnesses, thousands of starving people, it is an opportunity for the anarchist anti-authoritarian movement to place the matter of revolution in society, it is an opportunity given the conjuncture of the hunger strike of the political prisoners.

Because solidarity is connected with the revolutionary prospect, because political prisoners are in prison for their revolutionary actions, despite the different interpretations of the political prisoners themselves on this matter. Because solidarity to political prisoners should not be an introvert case that concerns the anarchist anti-authoritarian movement but must be a social matter. And in order for it to become a social matter, solidarity to the political prisoners must be connected with general political issues, the memorandums, the debt and the neo-liberal reforms and with the revolution that will delete the debt and subvert the State and capitalism that breeds the crises, intensifies oppression, upgrades the "anti-terrorist" legislation and builds C'type prisons. Besides, as said by the Assembly for Solidarity to political prisoners, prisoners and persecuted fighters in its founding text of its political positions, "Since we accept that solidarity to the imprisoned comrades is a part of the revolutionary movement and has an unbreakable relation with the struggle for the subversion and the revolution, then our actions promote not only the defence of prisoners against State oppression but are promotional for the struggle for subversion and revolution".

Comrades, if we agree on this, then we must connect the solidarity to political prisoners on hunger strike with the revolutionary prospect.

A demonstration that has a frame that connects solidarity to political prisoners with the crisis and the revolution will have a social and popular acceptance. The anarchist anti-authoritarian movement must stop thinking and acting with introversion, but be socially opened

Letter from Nikos Maziotis: To the Assembly for solidarity to the hunger strikers in Athens

Comrades, the political prisoners are already on the 10th day of the hunger strike. It is very positive that the assembly supports all the demands of the political prisoners, despite the differences in the frame of the demands, in order for no one to be left alone against State oppression. You are definitely already discussing solidarity acts that will take place in the immediate future. I know that one of these acts is a demonstration in the centre of Athens.

In my opinion, concerning this proposal, this demonstration should not exclusively have the characteristics of solidarity to the political prisoners on hunger strike, but must be connected and place the matter of the revolutionary prospect, the matter of revolution. Because social revolution and solidarity to the political prisoners are linked and directly connected.

The common political demands frame of political prisoners on hunger strike is very maximalist since it concerns the abolition of the anti-terrorist legislation. It is now understood by many comrades that the anti-terrorist legislation, the hoodie-law, the C'type prisons are linked to the increasingly authoritarian and totalitarian tendencies of capitalism here in Greece and internationally these last decades.

The enhancement of the legal and penal arsenal of the States, the intensification of repression is directly connected with the dictatorship of the markets and the fascism of the supranational economic elite that has been enforced, especially on the countries that are under the authority of international financial organizations such as the International Monetary Fund, the European Central bank and the political directorate of the European Commission, which have signed memorandums and rescuing programs like in Greece in 2010 and after.

Giorgos Polidoros and Christos Tsakalos have explained that the ten political prisoners of CCF support the other collective hunger strike that's currently underway in Greek prisons, emphasizing that the latest machinations of the antiterrorism agency against their family members are an extreme consequence of antiterrorism legislation. Nikos Maziotis has also stated that, regardless of the different context of the hunger strikes' demands, he supports the struggle of CCF prisoners.

Faced with this rapidly developing situation while waiting for further updates, it's up to those of us on the outside who fight to abolish the prison society in all of its aspects and to crush all Power, to support each and every prisoner in struggle for the immediate fulfillment of their demands, and try to bring about the complete destabilization of the system of domination. Let us not forget that what we fight for is the total destruction of the State/Capital, and that struggles for partial demands are used as a means of destabilization to this end, not as an end in itself; otherwise, there's always the danger of being assimilated into reformism. Let us multiply the actions of agitation and attack against institutions, persons and symbols of Greek democracy inside and outside the borders. Let us turn solidarity into praxis.



Greece: Statement signed by all the prisoners in the E1 wing of Domokos type C prison

Prisoner Giorgos Sofianidis began a hunger strike on Friday 27/2 demanding his transfer to Koridallos prison (where he was incarcerated until News Year's Eve) so that he is able to attend his studies in the same region where educational institutions to which he has already been admitted are available (besides, one of those schools operates inside Koridallos prison). Below is a statement by all the prisoners in the E1 wing of Domokos maximum security prison.

We, all the prisoners currently held in the E1 special wing in the prison within the prison, the type C prison of Domokos, declare that as of today February 27th 2015 we are going to abstain from prison meals and refuse to enter the cells at noon.

We stand by our fellow prisoner, hunger striker Giorgos Sofianidis, and ask that he be moved back to Koridallos prison, otherwise he risks losing any possibility to study at the TEI (Technological Education Institute) of Piraeus and the IEK (Institute of Professional Training) of Koridallos prison.

We demand that the special conditions of detention as well as the barbaric and inhumane type C prison be abolished.

Our mobilisations will continue until the type C prisons are permanently abolished.

Text by Nikos Romanos about the hunger strike of political prisoners

On March 2, Anarchists/political prisoners began a hunger strike with demands aiming the repressive context of the counter-terrorist crusade that goes on smoothly, despite the left governance of the traders of hope. The anarchist comrades involved in the Network of Fighting Prisoners (NFP) and comrades Maziotis, Koufodinas and Gournas have put in a general framework that depicts the development of repression in recent years. That's why each one of their demands separately deconstructs the emergency regime and its basic expression, which is none other than repression. After SY.RIZ.A was elected many comrades—including me—believed that there was a need for provocations from an anarchist perspective in order to force SYRIZA to reveal its true face. The face of capitalism, the face of the manager of modern powers, the face of the servant of capital. Besides, to this masquerade with guests from all historical periods, viewers are forced to discover that beneath all the masks hides face of power, which can neither be improved nor reformed, only destroyed, with continuous struggle by all means. And let all those anarchists that were dragged to the polls to cast a vote in SY.RIZ.A hear this. But it became obvious that SY.RIZ.A made a rapid shift from being the institutional arm of social struggles and its digestible rhetoric of the pre-election period to government realism as we all know it. Because the internationalized storm of repression that sweeps everything in its path is implicitly connected to the structural crisis of capitalism and its restructuring at all levels of social life. The royal-matte of domination to its subordinates goes on. After having bought their conscience by giving them membership cards to the capitalist paradise through bank loans, it is now trying to ensure their faith, in that democracy has no dead ends. Of course, the road to hell is always paved with the best intentions. And it's neither the first nor the last time that the Left has made some essential contribution to the strategic directions of world domination. So, the last act of the repressive puzzle took place with the arrest of comrade Angeliki and the pogroms of the counter-terrorism agency against relatives and friends of the Conspiracy of Cells of Fire.

The imprisoned anarchists who participate in DAK (Network of Imprisoned Fighters) Antonis Stamboulos, Tasos Theofilou, Giorgos Karagianidis, Dimitris Politis, Fivos Harisis, Argyris Ntalios, Andreas-Dimitris Bourzoukos, Grigoris Sarafoudis and Yannis Michailidis, the Revolutionary Struggle members Nikos Maziotis and Kostas Gournas, the 17 November (17N) member Dimitris Koufontinas, a number of political prisoners originating from Turkey, and the prisoners Giorgos Sofianidis and Mohamed-Said Elchibah are currently on hunger strike, fighting against the legal and repressive state of exception which has been established by the Greek state since the beginning of 2000.



On March 2nd 2015, we commenced a struggle together with the comrades outside the prison walls for abolition of type C maximum security prisons, abolition of the antiterrorist legislation, abolition of the hoodie law, for a fundamental change in the process of taking and identifying DNA evidence, and the release of the polytrauma patient, 17N member Savvas Xiros.

Our struggle for the fulfillment of these demands is a struggle against the very core of a state of emergency. It is a struggle against the very core of a new totalitarianism established over the past 15 years both in Greece and worldwide.

Recognizing the fact that the nexus between the plans of domination surpasses the narrow geographical boundaries of states, we call all comrades around the world to support our fight.

We call all fighters to carry out solidarity actions on April 1st, and thus send a message of revolutionary unity.

The moment the following words were written, we're on the 25th day of hunger strike, for the liberation of Christos and Gerasimos Tsakalos' mother, as well as the second one's girlfriend.

The pre-trial detention of our two comrades' relatives was an act of revenge by the judicial power against us, in retaliation for the escape we had prepared, with the bombing of the prison.

Now, reaching a tipping point between life and death, we want to share some thoughts with brothers and sisters, accomplices, comrades and anarchists all over the world. Of course, we know that upgrades of repression do not only occur in the Greek territory. They have already been applied in several countries, wishing to avenge anarchist deniers of the existent. Recently, in Chile, cops wanted to implicate the mother of the comrade Juan Aliste ("Security" Case) to a case of escape attempt of her son and his comrades. Moreover, in Spain, through Operation "Pandora", when comrades from the friendship circle of anarchist prisoner Monica Caballero were targeted, while relatives of the anarchist Tamara Sol, in Chile, during their visit in prison, suffered the revengeful sadistic "care" of the penal officers who wanted to inflict humiliating body searches on them.

A few words by anarchist Giannis Naxakis concerning the incidents that took place in Domokos prisons on Wednesday 25.3.15

The suffocating and authoritarian world reserved for us in its most vicious reality, the experience of living in physical incarceration, the tough consequence of a dangerous adventure. Living the existing dystopia we come up against the horror of the smell of death more and more often, more and more subtly.

Suicide in prison is the fact that speaks better than anything concerning this institution. This time however some of us in this prison-symbol of the institution, when hearing of the suicide of this prisoner of Pakistani origin who had stated his concerns, showed a sign of life by trashing the area of the wing, releasing in this way also much of the oppression accumulated inside us, having come to live in the opposite extreme of our desires.

The director and his mob of correctional officers hidden behind the fortification of the wing's outpost, received—even if just for a moment—a taste of guilt for the disgraceful role they play in this world.

For sure smashed windows and the destroyed installation of electronic control cannot mitigate all the disgust encompassed in this world. The disgust is here, it's there, it's everywhere and will always exist. It's how we stand before it that matters...

These attacks against relatives and friends of the anarchist prisoners seek to form an impassable moat of isolation around us. What the arrests, the verdicts and the prison bars failed to achieve, the emotional blackmail and the locking up of our beloved ones in the cells of democracy comes to accomplish. **The blackmail is clear: we either make a truce, or our relatives remain in prison. We're not going to sign any paper of repentance nor capitulate with power. We remain unrepentant anarchists and every day power keeps our people hostage, the wolf of negation and attack festers more and more inside us...**

We know that several comrades around the world, with whom we are connected through the complicity of anarchist action, feel numb towards the choice of hunger strike. As some close comrades from Croatia wrote to us, hunger strike, posing demands to power, in some sense, acknowledges it when it asks for their satisfaction. Somebody else could say the hunger strike looks like a reliance on emotions, which nourishes the traders of hope and humanism to play political games on our backs. We understand some concerns related to the method of the hunger strike as, in the past, we have shared them with each other. Besides, in several cases when we experienced the revenge of power upon us, we chose to act in a different way and not by hunger strike. **To put it simply: to war, we answer with war. Because our choice is always the attack.** But now we're not talking about ourselves. The hostages in prison are our relatives now. This is why we chose a hunger strike, to publicly expose the ugliness and morbidity of power. We are on the 25th day of hunger strike already and **we don't recognise a millimeter of donated ground by power to us.** Besides, we are aware that **freedom is conquered through the violence of our own actions and won't be given away by its laws.** But our relatives do not share the war we have declared against power, so they won't share our imprisonment. This is why we demand their immediate release from the cells of democracy.

We know that hunger strike is a slow death. But it is not our death. It is **the death of a society that remains dormant and quiet**

towards the fascism of power. We, therefore, take the responsibility to expose it further... This is why **the hunger strike we're on, is not a passive attitude, but a scream of attack that becomes praxis through the acts of solidarity.** It is a scream of attack that meets with thousands of voices in demos, with hundreds of hands that vandalize walls with slogans of solidarity, that hang banners, squat buildings, radio stations, government offices, and set a thousand fires to banks, state vehicles, political parties' offices, courts, in Greece, Italy, Chile, Mexico, Argentina, Czech, Spain, UK, Turkey and the soils of Kurdistan in battle. **So, the hunger strike, when connected with actions of attack, is not a plea for pity, but a call for action. This is why we call, from today, the hunger strike we're on to become a wager for the people of anarchy, for the Black International of the anarchists of praxis, for the FAI/IRF cells, for the comrades, for everyone who chooses to attack against order, peace and the laws of this world and its civilization. From today, through attacks all over the world, let us put forward the dilemma: either with anarchy, or with power.**

Because, on the background of the hunger strike for the release of the CCF comrades' relatives, in fact, two different worlds are competing: on the one hand, the world of power, order, regularity, law, judges, prisons and, on the other, the world of revolt, that of the streets, fire, freedom, anarchy...

Motorcycle demonstrations in solidarity with the hunger strikers that ended outside the prisons of Korydallos in Athens, Domokos in Larissa and Alikarnasos in Crete have also taken place, while demos and gatherings were also organized at a central level in many towns.

Other actions include occupations and interventions of academic and governmental buildings as well as direct actions such as incendiary attacks on governmental or security vehicles that will increase each passing day.

At the same time voices of solidarity with the struggle of the hunger strikers in Greek prisons have begun to be heard on an international level: from Madrid and Montevideo in Spain, to Uruguay and Chile where spontaneous actions of solidarity with banners and slogans have taken place, while more militant actions were carried out in Berlin with the torching of a squad car.

In this era of increased social and political repression we feel obliged to back the struggle of the Greek State hostages with all our strengths. It goes without saying that we will support their struggle with the communication and propagation of their claims and broadcast of the development of the hunger strike until the fulfillment of all their claims.

Additionally, Grigoris Sarafoudis, Andreas-Dimitris Bourzoukos and Dimitris Politis have also began hunger strike on 9th and 16th of March respectively. They are all members of the Network of Imprisoned Fighters, which, as already mentioned, has stated that more imprisoned fighters will join the hunger strike progressively.

It's also worth mentioning that anarchist prisoners whose trials are still running, stated that they will abstain from trial procedure until the demands of the strikers are satisfied.

According to the latest information the strikers' health has become critical and some of them have already been transferred to hospital for close monitoring.

Actions in solidarity

In this context a number of actions in solidarity have taken place and will continue to occur and multiply as the hunger strike develops.

Soon after the hunger strike began, solidarity assemblies were formed in many towns organizing actions at a local level in support to imprisoned hunger strikers.

On the 13th of March a Pan-hellenic Solidarity Action Day was organized followed by a number of actions in cities and towns all over the country while others also followed, namely in Chania, Rethimno, Heraklion, Veria, Lamia, Larisa, Thessaloniki, Agrinio, Volos, Mytilene, Karditsa, Trikala and many more.

Actions with a propagandist purpose (banners, posters, graffiti, solidarity texts, strikers' statements, PA gatherings) have been realized in order to inform people of the struggle of the hunger strikers, including direct interventions at local tv stations, radio stations, and other media close to the government.

Other actions have also taken place such as the symbolic occupation of the headquarters and other facilities of the government party Syriza at both central and local level.

Communique by the prisoners of Korydallos prison

Monday, March 30th, 2015

We, the prisoners of Korydallos prison, decided to scale up our reactions towards this insanity and injustice evolving in front of our eyes.

For about a month now, the judicial council that deals with the release of a 60-year-old mother and the wife of our fellow prisoner, Gerasimos Tsakalos, ostentatiously turns a deaf ear, playing with the life and the health of the hunger strikers, and the same policy is also followed by the Minister of Justice, which extends the passage of the bill, overtiring our fellow prisoners on hunger strike, whose demands concern all us prisoners and have to be satisfied.

There's no question of support here, as the problem is that of all prisoners who have a wife and a mother who visit them in prison.

It is the fascistic and discredited police and judges which try to avenge the relatives of the prisoners, because they have a problem with them.

We won't put up with our families paying for our own choices. They suffer enough pain already.

We have ran out of patience, in the face of this mother, we see our mother, and in the face of the wife, we see our own wives.

From today, Saturday 28/3, we refuse to go back into our cells at night and we let everyone take responsibility.

Those who are playing games with fire will face it and righteousness is on our side.

If anything happens to any hunger striker, those responsible will be held to account.

Whatever is to be, let it be!

medical care a hunger striker should have. The same applies to Fivos Charisis' case, in which we saw that arrogance has no limits when the director of the pathological clinic of Tzaneio Hospital, Stelios Drimis, with excess pride, was willing to sign the comrade's return to prison, putting the responsibility on him, as Foivos would not accept to receive serum. This incident is not an isolated case, but, as we have seen in previous hunger strikes as well, it completes the picture of full of EKAM and EOM (special police units) hospitals, with the strikers being denied visiting and correspondence, doctors collaborating with the police, doctors testing the endurance of hunger strikers by bringing them food and treating them disparagingly, playing the role of torturer much better than the one of the doctor. This scum is one of the above cases. We cannot overlook that part of the medical community which stands to the occasion helping by every means, understanding the seriousness of such a struggle.

IV. On Saturday night of the 28th of March, we visited Stelios Drimis' house in Nea Smyrni and placed an incendiary device (of low force) at the entrance. This action is a clear message to every potential torturer that nothing shall be done without consequences, nothing shall remain unanswered.

Every camera smashed inside a terror prison, every fire in the streets, is a message that the attack on the existent continues, where the passion for freedom is stronger than any cell.

Greece: Incendiary attack at the house of the doctor Stylianos Drimis (Athens, 28/03/2015)

On the 02/03 a struggle against modern anti-terrorist policy begins in prisons, a policy reflected in a series of repressive laws that confirm that there is a war between the world of authority and the world of struggle.

Anarchist and communist prisoners, from Greece and Turkey, with their bodies as weapons, are on a hunger strike, having as common demands the following:

- The abolition of C type prisons
- The abolition of paragraphs 187 and 187A (anti-terrorist law)
- The abolition of the law that considers it a statutory offense when a crime is committed while a person's characteristics are hidden
- The delimited usage of DNA as evidence
- The release of Savvas Ksiros

Meanwhile, the imprisoned members of CCF are also on a hunger strike, as well as Angeliki Spyropoulou, demanding the release of Gerasimos' and Christos' Tsakalos relatives.

II. For the first time such an important situation has occurred, a situation which due to its overall characteristics and demands does not only contain the imprisoned fighters, but a big part of society, too. This specific situation, also due to the change of government, leaves us no room for complacency and makes distinct the necessity to raise mounds against the dominion of the state and capital and defend our communities. We have no illusions, we are not moved by their leftist rhetoric. Because the whips may have changed hands, they, however, leave the same marks on the repressed ones' backs. We do not forget the recent invasions in fighters' houses, the suicide committed by a detained Pakistani in the dungeons of their prisons, the vengeful imprisonments of the relatives of CCF's members, the provocative statements made by the deputy minister of Citizen Protection Panousis. There is yet much more to see...

III. After many days of hunger strike the comrades have started being transferred to hospitals, where in some specific cases, the care being offered by the staff bears no resemblance with the

Since 02/03, the political prisoners are on hunger strike with the following demands:

- The abolition of the law articles 187 and 187A
- The abolition of the law dictating aggravated accusations when an action was carried out with concealed face characteristics (hood-law) – The abolition of type C prisons – The abolition of the law that allows violent DNA sampling
- Access and analysis of the DNA samples by a biologist the defendant trusts, if he/she wants to – The abolition of the analysis of DNA samples that contains a mixture of the genetic material of more than two persons and The immediate release of Savas Ksiros in order for him to receive the medical treatment he needs

As a minimum act of solidarity we placed an incendiary device at the entrance of Piraeus Bank in a central street of Kavala. This is only the beginning. For each day that passes and the demands of prisoners are not addressed, the attacks will continue.

Au lendemain des attentats du 11 septembre, la Grèce votait sa première loi anti-terroriste. Au fil des années, de l'aggravation de la crise systémique capitaliste et de l'aggravation du mouvement autocrate et anti-capitaliste grec, l'état a développé son arsenal anti-terroriste jusqu'à son apogée en décembre 2010. La loi sur les prisons de type C enfermement les prisonniers politiques et rebelles dans une section spéciale de haute sécurité qui confère un statut d'exception aux prisonniers considérés comme la déviation anti-terroriste : suppression des congés pénitentiaires, limitation des contacts avec l'extérieur et incompréhensibilité de leurs peines. En plus de cela, les prisonniers qui refusent de se repentir et de cesser leur combat et leur lutte pour une révolution sociale en Grèce voient leur peine de prison prolongée indéfiniment au lieu soixante jours.

En mai 2014, les détenus de prisonniers politiques enfermés dans les prisons helléniques se sont rassemblés, ont écrit une plateforme commune représentant tous les prisonniers politiques et révolutionnaires qu'ils soient ou non impliqués dans la question. Le seul critère déterminant est qu'ils soient pas collaboré avec la répression et qu'ils aient refusé de renier leurs idéaux révolutionnaires.

Cette plateforme lancée par Nikos Mavros (prisonnier de l'organisation lutte révolutionnaire) a reçu un écho certain à l'intérieur et à l'extérieur des prisons. Un grand nombre de prisonniers politiques ont rejoint la plateforme de gauche (idéologie Communiste Cellules de Feu) et à l'Organisation Prisonnière (Organisation) ont rejoint la plateforme du "DIAK", le Réseau des Combattants Prisonniers. A l'extérieur, des milliers de manifestants soutiennent les revendications du réseau dans les rues grecques (et dans bien d'autres pays). Ce mouvement est aussi plus que

jamais représentatif de l'importance de la solidarité dans le processus de révolutions sociale.

Le 2 mars 2014, plusieurs amis et membres de familles des prisonniers de la Casernes des Cellules de Feu (CCF) sont allés pour "appartenance" à un groupe "terroriste" à cause de leurs liens avec certains combattants. Immédiatement, les prisonniers de la CCF ont été en grève de la faim jusqu'à la mort ou jusqu'à la libération de leurs proches. Un même jour, d'autres prisonniers politiques avaient prévu de renouer en grève de la faim pour appuyer les revendications du DIAK qui sont:

1. Abolition des lois anti-terroristes,
2. Abolition de la loi anti-terrorisme et de la loi pour réprimer le soulèvement de décembre 2008,
3. Abolition de l'utilisation de l'IMM comme peine devant les tribunaux,
4. Abolition de la loi sur les prisonniers politiques de type-C,
5. Libération de Savvas Xiros, enlevé depuis 12 ans en Grèce et dans un état de santé dramatique.

Malgré les promesses officielles, SYRIZA n'a pas fait le moindre signe envers les nombreux prisonniers politiques enfermés en Grèce et n'a pas empêché que des familles de prisonniers soient jetées en prison sans aucun lien avec une quelconque organisation terroriste.

For our brothers and sisters inside and outside the walls, we don't forget that every day that dawns is closer for the walls of captivity to be thousands of debris and with anarchy as a weapon again and again to find ways to remain true and increasingly dangerous. For all the repressive assholes of the authoritarian complex, for every guard of every authority, cops, petty bourgeoisie, loyal employees, judges and statisticians, the snitches and the repressive moves against us are sad like what they serve and represents only their fear.

Authority will ever remain authority. No matter what kind of mask it may have, it never stops being stimulated by the frightened eyes of those who watch begging for a few sunbeams in their blank and colorless everyday life. As for our current rulers, they know this well. They know that in order to achieve social compromise they only need to feed their citizens with false hopes of change. The judicial authority as another Inquisition, instead of sending the rebellious ones to burn, buries them in the deepest dungeons of the “correctional” system. They forget, however, that as long as there is oppression, there shall also be the crazy ones, the misfits, those who don't comply with rules and will not stop, against the times, claiming everything. At the dawn of Sunday 05/03, we placed an incendiary device at the lobby of the central building of Piraeus Bank in the city center. This action was a practical solidarity sign for the political prisoners who are on hunger strike, fighting for: -

–The abolition of paragraphs 187 and 187A of the counter-terrorism law.

– The abolition of the aggravating provision for acts carried out with covered characteristics

– The abolition of type C prisons

– The abolition of the provision that imposes violent DNA taking – Access and analysis of the genetic sample by an expert biologist of the accused one's trust if he/she wants it
