### BEING FORCED ONTO WORK FOR THE DOLE?

If you do not want to Work for the Dole, inform your job agent that you would prefer to do another approved activity. These activities include voluntary work, part-time study or training. Additionally, if you earn an income that reduces your Newstart payment, by law you are ineligible for Work for the Dole

#### BEING THREATENED WITH A PENALTY?

If you are being threatened with a penalty, you should always ask your job agent to provide official government documentation justifying this.

#### BEING PRESSURED TO SIGN A JOB PLAN?

Under the law, you are not required to sign your job plan immediately. By law you can only be penalized after your second refusal to sign. This gives you the right to take your plan home and look it over carefully

#### WANT TO CHANGE EMPLOYMENT PROVIDERS?

There are a number of situations where you can change Providers. For example if you change address, have a relationship breakdown with your agent, or believe you can be better serviced elsewhere, by law you can request to change providers. Ask us how!
