

Parents: Support MUSIC as a well-rounded subject in your child's school district!



With the passage of ESSA, the new federal education law, parents and community members are invited to participate in creating district plans supporting a well-rounded education, including music.

Now's the time to step up and tell why music is important for your child.

Here's how:

- 1. Ask your child's principal if you can be involved in the district's Title IV planning process. Title IV is funding to support a well-rounded education, including music.
- 2. Be an active part of the process as your district creates its Title IV Plan. Make certain that the district understands the importance of music for all students in your district.
- 3. Learn about other ways to get involved like writing your school's plan for Title I if you are at a Title I school. Check with your principal to learn more.
