AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Few facilities are better served than Hong Kong International Airport when it comes to efficient airport transfers, with a choice of taxi, bus or high-speed Airport Express train. The Peninsula Hong Kong's newest fleet of 14 Rolls-Royce Extended Wheelbase Phantoms entered service in December 2006. All finished in signature Peninsula Green, each vehicle in The Peninsula's latest fleet has undergone bespoke modifications to suit the needs of guests, providing relaxed, comfortable and luxurious transportation to and from the airport.

Transfers by Rolls-Royce between The Hotel and Hong Kong International Airport are priced at HK\$ 1,600 per one-way trip, HK\$ 2,900 per round-trip or HK\$ 1,600 per hour for hire (with a minimum rental period of two hours).

Helicopter TRANSFER



For a speedy, luxurious and comfortable arrival in true Peninsula style, guests are invited to experience helicopter airport transfers from Hong Kong International Airport to The Peninsula Hong Kong's private helipad. This service is operated by Heliservices (Hong Kong), with twin-engine, air-conditioned MD902 Explorer helicopters, offering six VIP seats, luxury interiors and a world-class audio system. The flight is priced at HK \$22,500 from Hong Kong International Airport to The Peninsula Hong Kong (one-way) or vice versa (rate is subject to change).

Advance booking is highly recommended. No children under the age of two shall be carried unless they are secured in an approved child seatbelt. Please note that Heliservices has no child seatbelt available at this time.

Airport Express TRAIN

The Airport Express station is conveniently located on the arrival floor of the airport. It is an extremely fast and efficient way to reach Central (Hong Kong Station) or the Kowloon area (Kowloon Station), with complimentary shuttle buses running from the stations to various hotels. Trains operate daily from 6:00am to 12:30 am at 12-minute intervals, with the journey taking about 25 minutes from the airport to Central. Fares for one-way journeys are as follow:

Airport to Hong Kong Station:
Adult HK\$ 100 Child HK\$ 50

Airport to Kowloon Station:
Adult HK\$ 90 Child HK\$ 45

Taxi SERVICE

Taxis are safe and comfortable in Hong Kong, and are readily available at the airport. Depending on traffic conditions, the journey from the airport to Tsimshatsui or Central should take approximately 30 to 45 minutes. The fare from the airport to Tsimshatsui and Central will cost about HK\$ 350 and HK\$ 450 respectively, including bridge or tunnel tolls.

Hong Kong streets have many restricted areas where stopping for passengers to alight is not permitted, and so you may find that a taxi maybe unable to stop at your exact address.

Most drivers speak some English, however it is advisable to have your addresses or destination written in Chinese as well. The Concierge can assist you with this.
