

## American Deaths in Terrorist Attacks, 1995-2015

The following table presents statistics on the total number of terrorist attacks that took place in the United States, the total number of fatalities due to terrorist attacks in the United States (including perpetrators), the total number of U.S. fatalities due to terrorist attacks in the United States (including perpetrators), and the total number of U.S. fatalities due to terrorist attacks worldwide (including perpetrators, and excluding deaths in Afghanistan and Iraq), from 1995 to 2015.

**Effect of September 11, 2001 Attacks:** 3,140 Americans have been killed in terrorist attacks from 9/11/2001 through 12/31/2015, including perpetrators and excluding deaths in Afghanistan and Iraq.

- o 3,020 of these deaths occurred on American soil.
- 2,902 of these deaths occurred during the attacks on September 11, 2001.
