Uses made of the information

We use information held about you in the following ways:

Information you give to us

We will use this information:

- to provide you with the information, products and services that you request from us;
- to respond to your questions, comments and requests and may be used by us, or entities acting on our behalf, for marketing and quality assurance purposes;
- to provide you with information about other services we offer that are similar to those that you have already enquired about;
- to provide you, or permit selected third parties to provide you, with additional services and/or information about additional services that may interest you. If you are an existing customer, we will only contact you by electronic means (email or SMS) with information about services similar to those which were the subject of a previous dealing with you. If you are a new customer, and where we permit selected third parties to use your data, we (or they) will contact you by electronic means only if you have consented to this electronically;;

Information we collect about you

We will use this information:

Disclosure of your information

We may share your information with selected third parties.

Internet Protocol (IP) Address

An IP Address is a number that is automatically assigned to your computer every time you browse the Internet. When you visit this website, the server used by our Web Host will make a record of your IP Address, together with the date and time of your visit, the type of Internet Browser you use and the URL of any other website that referred you to this website. We do not link IP addresses to anything personally identifiable. Thus, each user session is anonymous.

We may also log IP Addresses (the electronic addresses of computers connected to the internet) to analyse trends, administer the website, track user movements, and gather broad demographic information.

Cookies

In some cases we may also collect your personal information through the use of cookies. When you access our website, we may send a "cookie" (which is a small summary file containing a unique ID number) to your computer.
