1	Walking around exhibit & animal precincts	<ul> <li>Student may lose school group and/or get lost.</li> <li>Slip, trip or fall</li> <li>Sunburn, heat stress, dehydration</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Ensure students are aware and prepared for walking through a large site</li> <li>Ensure students wear appropriate footwear</li> <li>Teachers must follow recommended supervision ratios of 1:4 for Preschool, 1:8 for Kindy Year 1 and 1:10 for above.</li> <li>Teachers/supervising adults should implement effective supervision strategies (e.g. Name badges, mobile contact number displayed on students, utilising Zoo staff in case of emergencies, regular roll calls and emergency meeting points.</li> <li>Zoo Staff with First Aid qualifications are on duty at all times within the Zoo.</li> <li>Ensure students are provided with adequate sun protection</li> <li>Teachers to be aware of undercover areas in case of hot weather</li> </ul>

2	Contact with animals & plants	<ul> <li>Diseases or allergies</li> <li>Animal bite or scratch</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Animals are always under the control and supervision of trained staff members or volunteers</li> <li>Animals are regularly checked for potential disease</li> <li>Students must wash hands after contact with animals with warm soapy water or use antibacterial foam (available various points around the zoo)</li> <li>Students are advised that they most not enter exhibit areas without approval or supervision by Zoo staff</li> <li>Do not enter signage is posted in areas which are prohibited by staff, public without proper authority</li> </ul>

3	Traffic hazards	Children injured by moving vehicles	Traffic speed limit of 10km/h for all vehicles within the car park.

Accessible Toilets	Disabled toilet facilities are located in 3 areas around the park.
Accessible exhibits	The Zoo and all animal exhibits are accessible to view by persons in a wheelchair.
Emergency procedures	Emergency procedures are in place and staff are trained to deal with emergency situations
Insurance	The Zoo has Public Liability Insurance, and a copy of our Certificate of Currency is viewable and downloadable form our Education page on our website.
