This CATHOLICISM **Topical Index** can be used to find content on a particular religious subject within the ten episodes of CATHOLICISM. Teachers or catechists can use the index to find clips to supplement or enrich their curriculum. Anyone who has the DVD series can use it to find specific footage about a wide variety of topics.

Each episode is broken down into tracked chapters, and the **Topical Index** lists both the episode and chapter where each individual topic can be found.

The Topical Index **Key Terms** are listed in the left-hand column. The episode numbers are listed across the top of each sheet in color-coded boxes. The numbers listed in the color-coded boxes below the episode number correspond to the chapter(s) where footage on the topic can be found. (Color-coding is provided for easier reading.)
