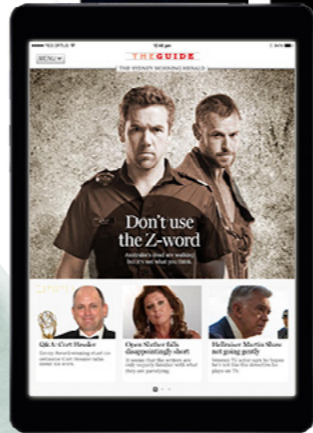

Livewire

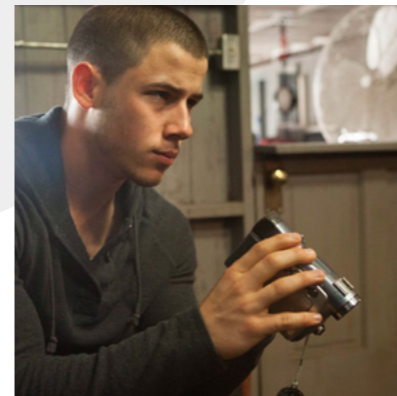
A contemporary sound and vision entertainment section, both technical and non-technical readers alike turn to the 'Livewire' feature for its authoritative voice on consumer technology.
