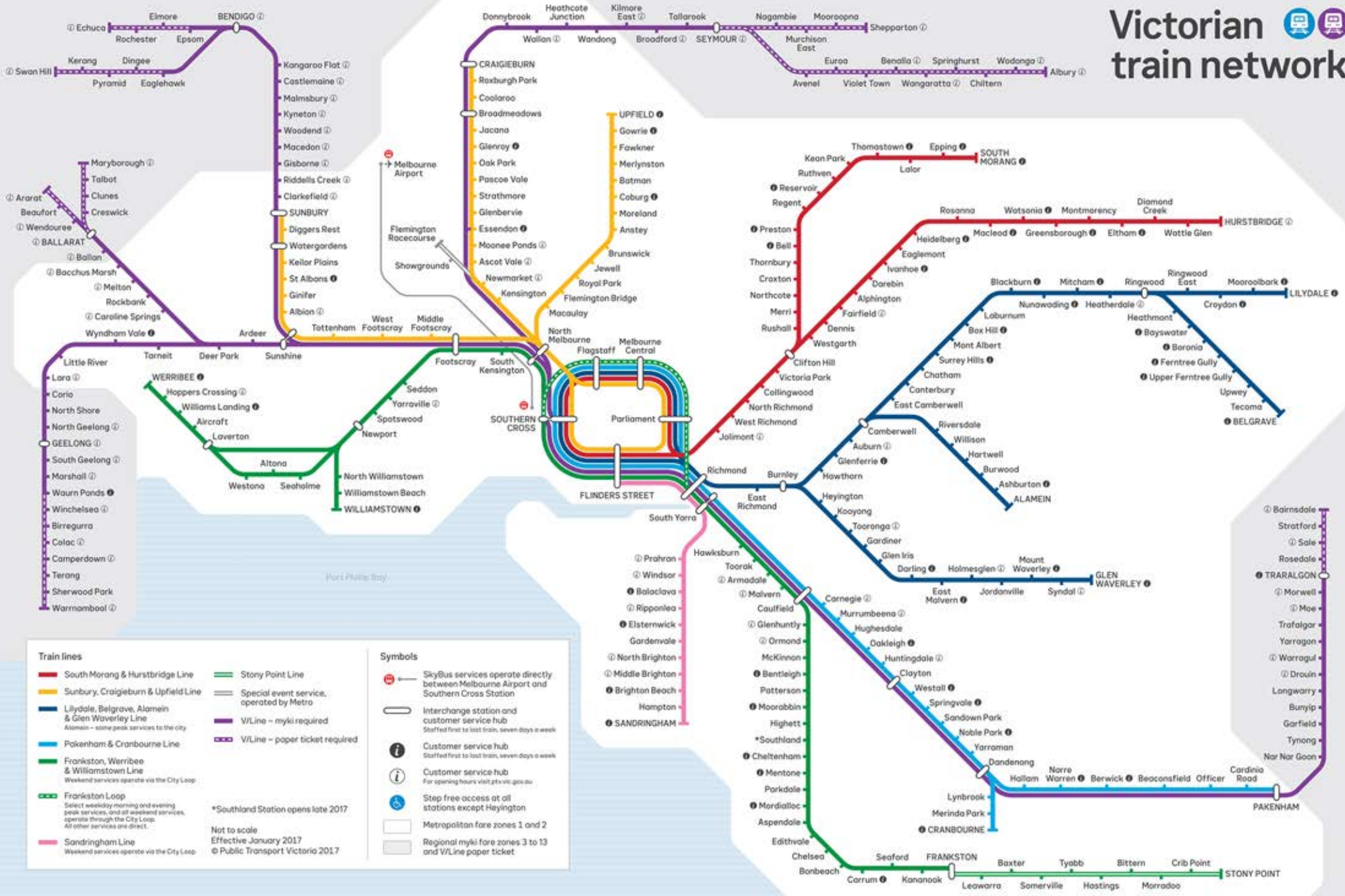


Victorian train network
