PROTECTED ACTION BALLOT UPDATE 1

What are the rules around a protected action ballot being approved?

Firstly 50% of AFULE members covered by the QR National Traincrew Enterprise Agreement 2010 have to return a vote. If less than 50% of those members return a vote the application fails.

Secondly, 50% of votes returned have to be in favour of the questions listed on the ballot.
