

NATIVE NAMES OF PLACES IN THE TALBOT DISTRICT.

Name as given on Map.	Native Name.	Meaning in English.
Mount Glasgow - -	Tout Bour Nay - -	Unknown. A volcanic mount known as Mount Glasgow.
Wonge Kurrup - -	Wonge Kurrup - -	Unknown. A volcanic mount on the west side of Tullaroop Creek, eight miles north of Clunes.
Wall Walp - -	Wall Walp - -	Unknown. At Major Mitchell's crossing over Tullaroop Creek, nine miles north of Clunes.
Big Swamp - -	Merrin-merrin - -	Unknown. A large swamp north of Clunes.
Big Water-hole - -	Moorangapil - -	Unknown. A lagoon near Talbot.
Tullaroop - -	Tullaroop - -	Unknown. A large creek running through Clunes.
Timor - -	Timor - -	Unknown. A creek running through Adelaide Lead into the Bet Bet Creek.
Naragil - -	Naragil - -	Unknown. A small creek running through the parishes of Amherst and Craigie.
Bet Bet - -	Bet Bet - -	Unknown. A large creek on the western side of the division.
Caralulup - -	Caralulap - -	Unknown. A parish in the south-western part of the division.
Lilicur - -	Lilicur - -	Unknown. A parish in the western part of division.
Bung Bong - -	Bung Bong - -	Unknown. A parish in the north-western part of the division.

NOTE.—There are no means of ascertaining the meanings of the native names in English. I have questioned some gins, but they are ignorant of them.—P. C. CRESPIGNY.
