They document the Bardi language, as spoken by David Wiggan, Adrian Isaac, Barry Stumpegee, Nancy Isaac, Jessie (Sampi) Wiggan, Dolly Davy and Bessie Ejai.

The collection was deposited at AIATSIS on 5 July 1991.
