Date: 1991 – 1992

Extent: 8 sound cassettes (ca. 60 min. each): analogue, mono. + field tape report sheets.

Production history

These recordings were collected by Sister June Barrett at Ringer Soak, Western Australia, between 1991 and November 1992 in the course of her work in the Kundat Djaru Community as a Sister of Saint Joseph of the Sacred Heart. Transcript includes photographs and paintings by informants. The predominant language is Jaru / Djaru language, but Nyininy language, Kriol language and English are included. The interviewees are Sheila Nabajayi Seela, Robert Jambiyin Rahla, Rosie Nangala Lala, Ruby Nabangari Nanggiya, Minnie Nambiyin Buranalli, Mun Mun Larrigan (Nabangari), Popeye Jangala Tchooga, Peter Jagamarra Gordon (Dawurrgurna), Clarice Naburru Gordon, Angela Nangari Gordon, Tchooga Naburrula, Linda Nambiyin Yandinalli, Winnie Nambiyin Wein, Ginger Janama Gordon and other unidentified speakers. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 1 March 2005.
