## **Production history**

These recordings were collected by Claire Bowern during a field trip with another linguist, Luise Hercus. Interviewees include Ivy Booth, Clancy Booth, Peter Hood and Margery Rowrow (Grey) who were living in either Cunnamulla or Rockhampton, in Queensland. The purpose of the field trip was to record the language and cultural practices, including tribal boundaries, geographical features as well as stories and songs of significance from people belonging to the Bundhamara, Gooreng Gooreng, Galali and Wangkumara language groups. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 5 May 1999.
