Production history

These recordings were collected by Gavan Breen between 27 August and 10 September 1968 in Andrewilla, SA, and Cluny, Glengyle and Windorah, Qld. The purpose of the recordings was to document languages spoken by various speakers in the northern SA and western Qld region, including: Yawarawarka, as spoken by Willy Harris; Wakaya, as spoken by Jimmy Larkins; Wangkangurru, as spoken by Clara Reece; Ngamini, as spoken by Maudie and Bob Naylor; Bundhamara, as spoken by Topsy Parker and Yandruwantha, as spoken by Mrs Tim Guttie.
