Production history

These recordings were collected between October 1963 and August 1964 by R. M. W. Dixon during fieldwork in southern Cape York, Queensland. The field trip was funded by an AIAS grant, and its purpose was to research languages from the rainforest region of Queensland, including Girramay, Dyirbal, Mamu, Dyalnguy, Malanbarra, Wargamay, Warungu, Nyawaygi, Yidiny and Mbabaram. Interviewees include Paddy Biran, Jack Murray, George Watson, Chloe Grant, Rosie Runaway, Jimmy Murray, Lorna, Mosley Dignan, Alf Palmer, Old Man Heron, Jack Stewart, Mrs Jack Stewart, Albert Bennett, Mick Burns and others, who provide narratives, conversation, vocabulary, sentences and songs in these languages.
