Production history

These recordings were collected between June 1972 and April 1978 at Marble Bar and Port Hedland, Western Australia and in Darwin, Northern Territory by Brian Geytenbeek and Helen Geytenbeek during fieldwork for the Summer Institute of Linguistics, Australian Aborigines Branch. The purpose of the field trip was to document the Nyangumarta language. Also recorded are the Nyiyaparli and Nyamal languages in the Marble Bar and Port Hedland regions. Interviewees include Mick Blair, Tobin Bin, Sam Coppin, Dooley Bin Bin [Winyirin], Jimmy Toile, Jack Horace, Lily Darby, Sam Mitchell, George Betts, Paddy Darby, Lily Boonyah, Big Paddie Boosil, Trixie Toile, Ross Gardiner, Robert Barrow-Caring, Tommy Dart, Billy Teedja, Lucy Wabing, Tinker Jalin, Mirlkapinya (Tommy Wallal) and Rosie Bunumba. The collection was deposited with AIAS (now AIATSIS) by Brian Geytenbeek and Helen Geytenbeek on 6 September 1978.
