Production history

These recordings were collected between August and December 1972 by Mrs Luise Hercus during fieldwork at Port Augusta, Innamincka, and Cordillo, SA., Birdsville, Qld., Broken Hill and Wilcannia, NSW. They document language elicitation and vocabulary, stories and songs by various speakers including Mick McLean, Arthur McLean, Maudie Naylon, Barney Coffin, Granny Moisey, Mrs Bates, Rupert Crow, Elsie Jones, Granny Bugmy, Laurie Quayle, Jack Johnson, Mrs Bradley. Languages documented in these recordings include Yarluyandi, Arabana, Wangkangurru, Wiljali, Yardliyawara, Parrintyi, Southern Paakantyi, Kurnu/ Gunu and Malyangapa.

The collection was deposited with AIATSIS in August 1973.
