#### **Production history**

These recordings were collected between 28 October and December 1967 by linguist Bjorn Jernudd during fieldwork at Kulaluk / Bagot, Gunbalanya / Oenpelli and Barunga / Bamyili in the Northern Territory of Australia. The purpose of the field trips was to research the Djinang, Gunwinggu, Alawa, creoles and Aboriginal English of the Top End. Dr Jernudd also recorded meetings of the Bagot Council and conversations among the residents of Bagot and Gunbalanya. Speakers include Dick Smith, Joseph, Billy, Jacob Lanson, Steven Turner, Carolyn Moreen, Elizabeth McCormack, Ruth Joshua, Jacob, Eva Rodgers, Beryl, Lisa, Robert, Nellie, Eileen, Abe, Anna, George Woodruff, Mrs Woodruff, Joy White, Betty, Mr Wilson, Mickey, Charlie, Alf, Clancy Roberts, Paula, Matthew Thompson, Max Baden, Mrs Baden, Margaret, Mrs Evans, Don, George, Joe, Michael, John Wright, Peter Lanson, Alf, Nathaniel, Andrew, Moses, Jacob Nayinhgul, Peter Carob, Nathaniel Nabamdjole, Moses Manjaraba, Timothy, Silus, Dexter Daniels and Stanley.
