## **Production history**

These recordings were collected by Dr Wolfgang Laade of the Freie Universität, West Berlin, between 1963 and 1965. They document Eastern Torres Strait songs and stories, as well as songs from various Pacific islands and mainland Australia. The research was funded by the Australian Institute of Aboriginal Studies (AIAS).
