Production history

These recordings were collected in January 1981 and on 18 February 1981 by Richard K. Larson while on fieldwork at Yuendumu. They document a sequence of songs in Warlpiri leading up to initiation of a boy from Jangala/Jampijinpa semi-moiety. Included are women's Dreaming songs, recounting the dream-time travels of women as they danced a long a mountain range, and men singing portions of the Rain Dreaming. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 10 March 1981.
