Production history

These recordings were collected between 20 August and 11 September 2003 by linguists David Nash and Jane Simpson during fieldwork at Battery Hill, Tennant Creek in the Northern Territory of Australia. The collection contains elicitation of appropriate Warlmanpa words and sentences, based on illustrations in *Central Anmatyerr Picture Dictionary* compiled by Jenny Green with Ti Tree, Mount Allan and Laramba (Napperby) communities. The speakers are May Foster Napanangka, Julie James (nee Kelly) Nakamarra and Janet Napurrula. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 6 June 2004.
