Production history

These recordings were collected between 1960 and 1962 by anthropologist Dr Marie Reay during fieldwork in Beswick, Roper River, Borroloola, Groote Eylandt, Goulburn Islands, Cape Don, Maningrida and Calvert River, N.T., and Normanton and the Torres Strait Islands, Qld. They document stories, songs and performances from several different language groups including Anindilyakwa, Garrwa, Mayali, Rembarrnga, Wulagi, Yanyuwa and Alawa. Interviewees and performers include Floriti, Helen, Molly Bungurimera, Agnes Budgamara, Jingle, Maggie Yuendya, Gilbirr, Rosu, Elphine, Josephine, Rosemary, Spider, Jack Williams, Jemima, Willie Ngawuji and unidentified participants. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS in March 1976.
