Production history

These recordings were collected by Bruce Rigsby between 6 June and 18 June 1974 in Coen, North Queensland, Australia. They document languages spoken by various people in the area, including Kuku Thaypan as spoken by Molly Gordon and Christmas Shepherd; Wik Mungkan as spoken by Oscar Gordon; Olgol as spoken by Oscar Gordon; Umbuygamu as spoken by King Armstrong; Umbindhamu as spoken by Joan Liddy; Kaanju as spoken by Jack Shepherd; and Aboriginal English as spoken by Nola Ahlers and several children. The collection was deposited at AIATSIS in June 1974.
