Production history

These recordings were collected between 9 February and 11 March, 1999 by Teresa Ross Napurrurla during fieldwork at Alice Springs, Willowra, Boomerang Rockhole and Mudhut in the Northern Territory. The field trip was funded by an AIATSIS grant to document the events collectively known as the Conniston Massacre (1928) from older Warlpiri people who survived these events. The interviewees included Jack Jakamarra, Lady Napaljarri Morton, Benny Jakamarra Nelson, Paddy Jakamarra Willis, Jimmy Jungarrayi Kitson and Sandy Japangardi Williams.
