Production history

These recordings were collected by Professor Tasaku Tsunoda from the Faculty of Letters at the University of Tokyo. They were created in July and August of 1996 during fieldwork in and around Halls Creek in Western Australia and Darwin, Northern Territory. The purpose of the field trips was to document document the Wanyjirra, Ngarinyman, Kija, Jaru, Gooniyandi and Nyulnyul languages and some histories of the areas. Interviewees include Maggie Scott, Henry Pilot, Raymond Rodgers, Najinga Scott, Finnigan Quilty, Robert Jabanungga, Jack Jugayarri, May Butcher, Doris Rider, Marylin Rider, Bonnie Deegan, Molly Lightning, Flora Wallaby, Sister Elma, Theressa Puertollano, Masie, Sister Francis Dunn, Sister Camille, Doctor John C Hargraves and Sister Joan Fong. The collection was deposited with AIATSIS on 2 October 1996.
