Production history

These recordings were collected between 2008 and 2009 by AIAITSIS grantees linguist Christina Eira and research assistant Vicki Couzens on behalf of the Victorian Aboriginal Corporation for Languages during fieldwork at Adelaide in South Australia, and Melbourne, Geelong, Morwell, Orbost, Wendouree and Framlingham in Victoria. The purpose of the field trips was to interview people who have been involved in Indigenous language revival and revitalisation projects, particularly in Victoria. Those languages include Kaurna, Kurnai, Wathawurrung / Wada wurrung / Wathaurong, Daungwurrung / Taungurong, Gunditjmara, Giraiwurung / Girrea / Kirrae Whurrong, Awabakal, Waywurru Dhudhuroa and Boonwurrung / Boonerwrung / Bunurong.
