Production history

These recordings were collected by Alex van der Leeden on 29 January 1964 and 29 January 1965 at Numbulwar in the Northern Territory. They document clan songs in Nunggubuyu and Anindilyakwa performed by Jingjingi, Lalbidj, Ri'mili and Grass. The field work was funded by an AIAS grant to research the social structure at Rose River. Funding may also have been obtained from the National Museum of Ethnology, in the Netherlands.
