## **Production history**

The provenance of these recordings has yet to be established. It is thought that these are recordings of Professor Stephen A. Wurm orally translating into English from transcriptions / field notes of his own from interviews with speakers of the Indigenous languages Galali and Guwamu recorded in April 1963 and December 1955 respectively. With the Guwamu material this is almost certain. The date '1976' is a key found on a note from linguist Peter Austin to professor Wurm on an envelope containing the Galali Field notes / transcriptions. The deposit also contains documentation related to GROGER-WURM collections.
