Preferred Site

It is unlikely that a medium or high power site will be available. Therefore the preferred site is at the council owned depot in Adam St. The site has an existing roof mast however this would not be suitable for an FM antenna. A 20m light duty steel pole will give enough height above the surrounding terrain to give suitable coverage. The equipment can be located within the depot. A vertically polarised transmission with ERP of 200W and an omnidirectional pattern will give an urban grade of service to most of the Bendigo metropolitan area. The remainder of the metropolitan area will be supplied a suburban and rural grade of service. See attached coverage map. The coverage map was produced using Pathloss 4.0 prediction software and Auslig 9 second terrain data.
