

A classy news/weblog tool (aka logware).

How does it work?

You type something and hit "blog this" and in the next second it's on your page(s). You can write extended entries, or even entries that span multiple pages. You can also use BloggerAPI clients to post to your b2 weblog.

What's original in b2 ? Pages are generated dynamically from the MySQL database, so no clumsy 'rebuilding' is involved. It also means faster

Catechesis

The instructional notes listed among the sub-pages are those that I have used in adult catechesis. PLEASE NOTE that there are additional sub-pages under prayer that discuss this topic in greater detail. The notes are not meant to be comprehensive, just a help in grasping the general points of Catholic faith.

I have also included a "Questions and Answers" section that discusses the faith from the perspective of the usual queries or concerns that people raise. A few of them could arguably have been assigned to the section of my Blog dealing with apologetics and anti-Catholicism.

Not wanting to forget the children, I have added notes that I corrected and updated a few years ago that examine what young people should know during each year of their faith formation.

These days it is not enough to simply memorize the dictates of faith; we must be able to argue it coherently, especially against those who are less than sympathetic to it. However, the sad truth is that many young people do not even the basics of doctrine. Ignorance quickly translates to false religion and defection.

I was the product of CCD, having not attended either a Catholic elementary or high school. However, the truth is that I was a sickly child who read books, even ones about religion, and talked to God daily. When I reached high school, the CCD teacher essentially kicked me out, telling my father that I did not have to attend any longer. Why? He said I knew everything already. The truth be told, I sometimes corrected him, albeit a good man, and it made the other students feel stupid, unfortunately the real state of affairs.

I missed the relationships, having really enjoyed CCD. But I must admit that much improvement and some of our Catholic schools are doing good work.
