**Invoicing:** Professional fees and expenses are invoiced separately:

- 1. <u>Professional Fees:</u> An invoice for services provided between August 20, 2015 and October 19, 2015 is attached and due upon execution. Thereafter, BGR will invoice The Center on the first day of the quarter starting October 20, 2015.
- 2. Expenses: BGR will invoice The Center on the last day of each month for expenses incurred during the month prior, starting August 31, 2015.

Regardless of the ultimate duration of the Agreement, all invoices generated from the terms and between the two parties to this Agreement are payable in-full and promptly upon receipt and shall be paid directly to BGR within thirty (30) days of receipt of all documents.

<u>Confidentiality:</u> BGR recognizes that in the course of our representation, we could become aware of information, practices or policies, which you wish kept confidential. BGR shall not during the term of this Agreement or afterwards, disclose any proprietary or confidential information learned in the course of its representation of The Center without prior written consent of The Center, to the extent permitted by law.
