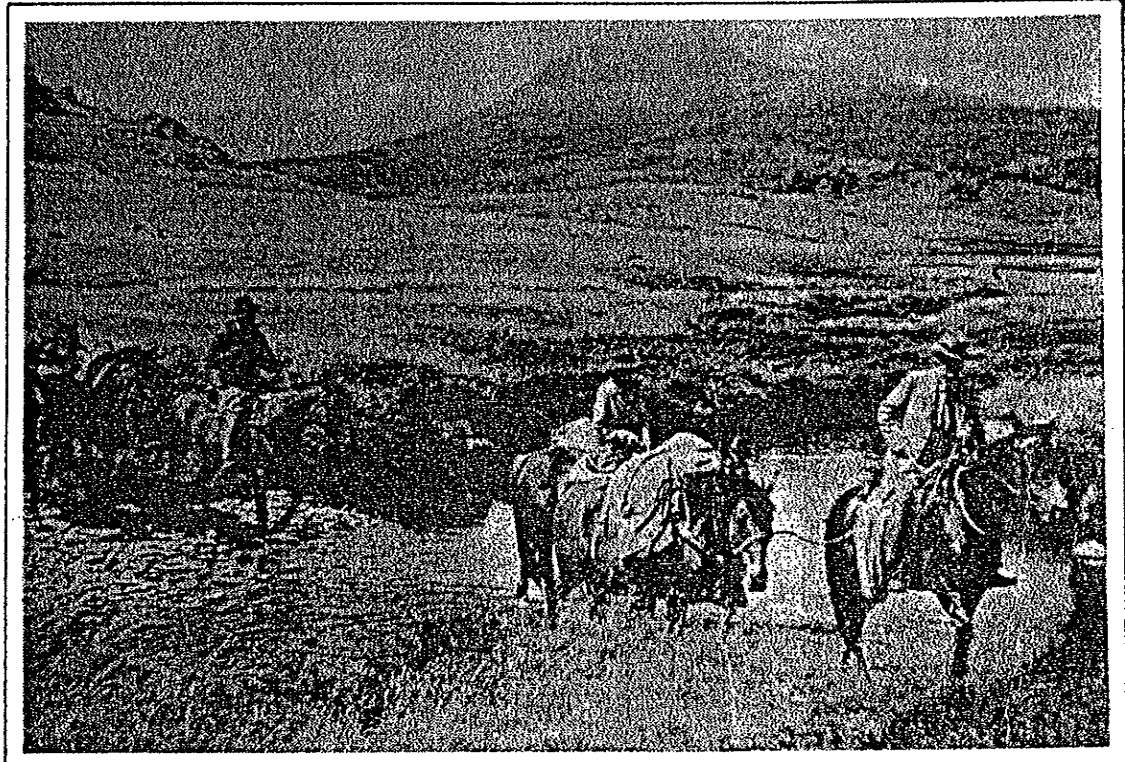

Comments : Caroline Vitnell came to Dubbo from Mudgee and worked for the manager of the Gas Works as a housekeeper. In 1893 she married a meter maker for the Gas Works, George Paul who had come to Dubbo in 1887, two years after having arrived from New Zealand.

They lived in Paul's Lane, running between Brisbane and Macquarie Streets in the vicinity of the present Grace Bros Store.

In 1909, the family moved to the Gas Works residence in Brisbane Street, North Dubbo. George was the manager, a position he held until 1926, when the increasing use of electricity made the position redundant. From Dubbo the family moved to Queabeyan, where George worked as a plumber and in 1940 Caroline and George moved to Sydney.

As well as family commitments, Caroline was involved with work for the Methodist Church and she was a founding member of the Women's Christian Temperance Union.
