GARAGE AND WORKSHOP.

A Forestry, one balanda Mechanic bloke was interested in fixing Aboriginals own vehicles last year (Kunmal) at Maningrida. I believe he did that for friendship (lundu) and didn't want money (rupia) for his many hours work (djama), but we would like to say thank you with carvings (djungi), woomeras (bunduk), hooked spears (matjalangu), shovel nosed iron bar (kayit), stone spears (djangul) or didgeridoos (wunbal).

Jinang and Wulaki people (barbururr) were painting barks for him (bambulli) and making spears (djarak) etc. They were also getting all parts (kirri) for their motor ears from Darwin (burunga). This means that everybody was satisfied and in this way they helped each other. This baland man worked on Jinang landrover, Jinang landrover, Jinang Falcon and another few tribesmen's trucks.

ARTISTS AT THE BACK GROUND.

Anyone who wishes to buy bark paintings, then he goes to the Arts and Crafts house to see Dan Gillespie and Peter Bandjuljul. They are the people who are looking after our values and prices. But if you go straight down to the artists at the camp (kurbi), the painters will be asking for plenty of money (rupia). Those prices at the back ground see for example one small bark costs \$20.00, one large painting costs \$100.00.

This is because many of our people cannot count big money and when people come to the camp to buy something, we don't know what price to ask. Therefore some people ask for beer, wine, spirits and other things and some balandas may think we are robbing people.
