# INVESTOR'S BUSINESS DAILY/TIPP POLL, APRIL 2016

# ABOUT THE POLL

TechnoMetrica Market Intelligence conducted the Investor's Business Daily/TIPP poll from March 28 through April 2, 2016. A total of 902 Americans aged 18 or older participated in the nationwide survey. The margin of error for the poll is +/-3.3 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

TechnoMetrica uses "traditional" telephone methodology using live interviewers for data collection for its public opinion surveys. Using a computer-assisted telephone interviewing (CATI) system, we conduct our interviews from our call center in Ramsey, NJ.

Of the 902 interviews, 556 (62%) came from a cell phone sample and 346 (38%) from a Random Digit Dial (RDD) land line sample. We use regional quotas based on four census regions and nine census divisions.

We do not use a predictive dialer; our interviewers dial all telephone numbers by hand, and thus potential respondents always connect to a live interviewer when they pick up the phone. On weekdays, we interview between 5 p.m. and 11 p.m. EST and on weekends between 4 p.m. and 11 p.m. EST. For quality control, our supervisors monitor randomly selected interviews.

For landline, we use youngest male/oldest female procedure for respondent selection. For wireless sample, we ensure that it is a good time for the respondent to participate in the research. In order to fine-tune results of any given poll, we weight using a proprietary model using variables such as age, gender, race, and region among others.

Please note: the unweighted sample size for Registered Republicans/Lean Republican is 388 with a margin of error of +/- 5.1 percentage points. The unweighted sample size for Registered Democrats/Lean Democrat is 383 with a margin of error of +/- 5.1 percentage points.

# OUR PERFORMANCE

The IBD/TIPP Poll has a proven track record for accuracy, based on its performance in the past three presidential elections. In a comparison of the final results of various pollsters for the 2004 and 2008 elections, IBD/TIPP was the most accurate. And the New York Times concluded that IBD/TIPP was the most accurate among 23 polls over the three weeks leading up to the 2012 election.
